

2019 Admission Information for International Students of Kunming Medical University

Introduction

Kunming Medical University was founded in 1933 and has since established itself as the largest specialized medical university of higher medical education, scientific research and medical service in Yunnan, P. R. China. KMU has educated over 100,000 graduates since its inception. KMU has three campuses which occupies about 98.8 hectares. It has 13,245 undergraduate students, 3,213 post-graduate students, and 514 foreign students. It has 6,366 staff and faculties. There are 18 schools (departments), 32 undergraduate majors, 128 post-graduate majors and 116 doctoral majors(including Chinese and English mediums). 16 affiliated hospitals with over 22,000 beds and 152 practice sites which provide a stable study and practical environment for students. Since 1998, KMU has recruited and trained graduate students, undergraduate students, medical elective students and Chinese language learning students from over 40 countries and regions.

Programs for international students

Undergraduate Program

Non academic program

1. Clinical elective programs

Clinical electives for international students with an aim to improve their medical knowledge and skills, and help them to have a better understanding of Chinese medical education and its on going development. The program provides courses in two fields: clinical observation and laboratory techniques. Students are required to decide their interested fields before admission.

2. Chinese language learning programs

Long-term Chinese courses ranging from 1 year to 3 years for language students and various-level of short-term Chinese courses. Students will receive all-round training in terms of listening, speaking, reading, and writing.

Qualifications for admission

1. Applicants who must be non-Chinese citizens and be in good health, good character and abide by the laws and regulations of People's Republic of China and the regulations of KMU.

2. Requirements for applicants:

Undergraduate programs: Age:18-30, senior high school graduates or those with the same or above level, average score of senior high school should above 75.

Master programs: Age:18-35, Bachelor's Degree or those with the same level, average score of undergraduate stage should above 70.

Doctoral programs: Age:18-40, Master's Degree or those with the same level, average score of

post-graduate stage should above 70.

Chinese language study program: Academic achievement qualified in the Previous Stage.

Medical elective program: Having medical professional education backgrounds.

3. Language requirements:

Chinese medium programs: HSK Level 4 and above.

English medium program: Applicants for English medium program should submit corresponding english proficiency certificate. MBBS applicants for English-language programs must have strong english language proficiency. Applicants from non- english native language countries must have an IELTS, TOEFL or other English test score (IELTS score not less than 6.0, the individual score is not less than 5.0) .The TOEFL Internet-based Testing score is not less than 85 points, the individual score is not less than 20, or the Paper-based Testing score is not less than 580 points. Other English proficiency test scores refer to the IELTS and TOEFL scores). Applicants who speak English as their native language or applicants who are taught in English at the middle school are exempt from the IELTS or TOEFL score report, but must submit the English scores in the middle school and the English language certificate issued by the school.

Admission procedure

1. Apply on the website: <http://study.kmmc.cn>, the scholarship program applicants can refer to the annual recruitment brochures.

2. Necessary documents should be provided as follows:

- (1) Scan copy of application form;
- (2) Scan copy of passport;
- (3) Scan copy of physical check form;

Applicants must fill in and print the application form after submitting it online. The CSC Online Application for Study in China is available in <http://laihua.csc.edu.cn>.

- (4) Scan copy of notarized highest Diploma Certificates;

- (5) Scan copy of notarized transcript;
- (6) Scan copy of HSK4 and above (Chinese medium program applicants) ;
- (7) Scan copy of english proficiency certificate (English medium program applicants) ;
- (8) Curriculum Vitae;
- (9) Scan copy of payment guarantee letter which must be signed by applicants' parents;
- (10) Scan copy of non-criminal certificate;
3. KMU will mail JW202 Form and Admission Notice to the qualified candidates.
4. The qualified applicants should remit fees to KMU in terms of Admission Notice.
5. All qualified applicants shall register in Section of Students Service of International Education School on the dates specified in the Admission Notice. Students who are unable to register within two weeks after the deadline are considered as abandoning their application in KMU.
