Kunming Medical University

Introduction

Kunming Medical University (KMU, formerly known as Kunming Medical College) was founded in 1933 and has since established itself as the largest specialized medical university of higher medical education, scientific research and medical service in Yunnan, P. R. China. KMU has educated over 100,000 graduates since its inception. KMU has three campuses which occupies about 109 hectares. It has about 15,000 students, of which 2,811 graduate students and 6,199 staff and faculties, 1,450 professors and associate professors. KMU has over 60 foreign scholars as honorary professor and guest professor. There are 18 schools (departments), 15 affiliated hospitals with over 10,000 beds and 69 practice sites which provide a stable study and practical environment for students. Since 1998, KMU has recruited and trained graduate students, undergraduate students, advanced medical training students and Chinese language learning students from over 30 countries and regions.

2. Master programs (3-year programs)

3. Doctoral programs (3-4 years programs)

Internal Medicine, Surgery, Obstetrics & Gynecology, Pediatrics, Geriatrics, Neurology, Psychiatry and Mental Health, Dermatology and Venereology, Imaging and Nuclear Medicine, Clinical Laboratory Diagnostics, Nursing, Ophthalmology, Otolaryngology, Oncology, Sports Medicine, Rehabilitation and Physical Medicine, Anesthesiology, Emergency Medicine

4. Clinical elective programs

Clinical electives for international students with an aim to improve their medical knowledge and skills, and help them to have a better understanding of Chinese medical education and its on going development. The program provides courses in two fields: clinical observation and laboratory techniques. Students are required to decide their interested fields before admission.

5. Medical training programs

Traditional Chinese Medicine training program, such as massage, acupuncture, cupping therapy, etc. Combination of Chinese and Western Medicine training program and western medicine training program for the people who are interested in these fields to have a short time medical training.

6. Chinese language learning programs

Long-term Chinese courses ranging from 1 year to 3 years for language students and various-level of short-term Chinese courses. Students will receive all-round training in terms of listening, speaking, reading, and writing.

Language:

Chinese or English is the studying language in both hospitals and laboratories. French can be used in some departments in the hospitals.

Qualifications for admission

Those who are in good health and abide by the laws and regulations of People's Republic of China

and the regulations of KMU are welcome to attend our university.

Requirements for applicants:

1. Undergraduate programs: Senior high school graduates or those with the same or above

level. Age: under 25, the average score of the School-leaving Exam including English, physics, chemistry and biology shall be, in general, minimum 75%

Master programs: Bachelor's Degree or those with the same level

Doctoral programs: Master's Degree or those with the same level

- **2. English medium program:** English level: the average records of English should above 70; HSK Level: above Level 4
- 3. Chinese medium programs
- ① Undergraduate program: HSK Level above Level 4
- 2 Graduate program: HSK Level above Level 6

Application date: March - August of each year

Admission procedure

 Submit the following documents to Section of Students Service, International Education School of KMU:

(1) * Scan copy of application form (two pages):

- a. *First page: with photo pasted, name, date of birth, passport number shall be exactly same with the passport scan copy.
- b. *Second page: it is a guarantee letter which shall be signed by the applicant, and must be a scan copy;
- (2) *Scan copy of photo page of passport;
- (3) * Scan copy of physical check form with report of blood check;
- (4) Scan copy of senior high school graduate certificate;
- (5) *Scan copy of senior high school transcript;
- (6) Scan copy of senior high school character certificate;
- (7) *Scan copy of payment guarantee letter which must be signed by applicants' parents.

Remark: items with * are necessary materials.

- Application documents will be reviewed and verified by the end of August every year by KMU. Section of Students Service of International Education School will mail JW202 Form and Admission Notice from KMU to the qualified candidates.
- 3. All the candidates shall register in Section of Students Service of International Education School on the dates specified in the Admission Notice. Candidates who are unable to register within two weeks after the deadline are considered as abandoning their application in KMU.

International students are responsible for their tuition and all other fees, including housing, medical care, meals, and any incurred miscellaneous expenses.

Scholarship:

- ★ Qualified MBBS (Clinical Medicine, English Medium) students, except students who receive Government Scholarship (National or Provincial), are eligible to apply Kunming Medical University Scholarship: 2% students for 8,000RMB/year; 4% students for 5,000RMB/year scholarship; and 9% students for 3000RMB/year.
- ★ Students from Southeast Asian and South Asian countries including Thailand, Vietnam, Myanmar, Laos, Cambodia, India, Nepal, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka are eligible to apply Yunnan Government Scholarship in KMU from February to April every year.
- ★ Foreign students are eligible to apply Chinese Government Scholarship (CSC Online Application for Study in China is available in http://laihua.csc.edu.cn) from January to April every year online.
