I. Admission Programs

1. Degree Programs

Full-time undergraduate, master's, and doctoral students in medicine-related majors.

2. Non-degree Programs

Medical advanced training students and Chinese language advanced training students.

II. Majors Offered

III. Application Eligibility

1. Applicants must be foreign citizens with good moral character, physical and mental health, excellent academic performance, friendly attitudes toward China, and the ability to abide by the laws and regulations of the People's Republic of China and the rules of Kunming Medical University. Chinese citizens who have immigrated abroad and

apply for undergraduate programs as international students must hold a valid foreign passport or nationality certificate for at least four years (inclusive) and have resided abroad for more than two years in the past four years (as of April 30 of the enrollment year). Residence of at least nine months in a year counts as one year (based on entry and exit stamps). Applicants meeting these conditions must provide relevant proof and undergo university review.

2. Academic Background and Age Requirements

(1) Bachelor's degree applicants: High school graduation or equivalent academic qualification, age 18–25.

(2) Master's degree applicants: Bachelor's degree or equivalent, major closely related to undergraduate studies. For non-Chinese university graduates, the institution must be officially recognized by the Chinese Ministry of Education, age 18–35.

(3) Doctoral degree applicants: Master's degree or equivalent, major closely related to master's or undergraduate studies. For non-Chinese university graduates, the institution must be officially recognized by the Chinese Ministry of Education, age 20–45.

(4) Medical advanced training applicants: Bachelor's degree or higher in a medicine-related major, age 18–50.

(5) Chinese language advanced training applicants: High school graduation or equivalent academic qualification, age 18–50.

3. Language Proficiency Requirements

(1) Chinese-taught programs: Ability to study in Chinese, with Chinese proficiency at least at Level 4 of the International Chinese Language Proficiency Standard (HSK4).

(2) English-taught programs: Applicants must have strong English language skills and solid foundational science knowledge. Non-native English speakers must provide IELTS Academic (minimum 6.0, no band below 5.0), TOEFL (Internet-based test minimum 70, no section below 15), or equivalent English test scores. Native English speakers or those who completed secondary education entirely in English are exempt from English test scores but must submit proof of English grades and English-medium instruction from their secondary school.

4. China Scholastic Competency Assessment (CSCA)

Mathematics and physics are mandatory subjects. All applicants of undergraduate programs must hold a valid "China Scholastic Competency Assessment (CSCA)" score report from within the past year. IV. Application Period

1. Self-funded degree programs: January 1, 2026 – July 31, 2026.

V. Application Process

1. Online Application

Applicants must apply online via the Kunming Medical University International Student Admission Platform (<http://study.kmmc.cn> or <https://kmmc.17gz.org/>). Scholarship applicants should refer to the "Kunming Medical University 2026 International Student Scholarship Program Admission Brochure." The following documents must be uploaded during online application:

- (1) Passport photo page (must be valid);
- (2) "Foreigner Physical Examination Form" and blood test report;
- (3) Notarized highest diploma, degree certificate, and academic transcripts in Chinese or English;
- (4) HSK Level 4 or above certificate (mandatory for Chinese-taught programs or English-taught clinical medicine master's degree applicants);
- (5) English proficiency test scores (mandatory for English-taught

program applicants);

(6) China Scholastic Competency Assessment (CSCA) score report (undergraduate program applicants must upload it, Mathematics and physics are mandatory subjects. CSCA website: <https://csca.cn/>.)

(7) Personal resume and study plan;

(8) Two recommendation letters from professors or associate professors (mandatory for graduate program applicants);

(9) Financial guarantee documents (mandatory for self-funded program applicants);

(10) Non-criminal record certificate.

***Important:**

● Uploaded materials must be clear, authentic, and valid. Professional scanning equipment is recommended. Consequences due to unclear or unidentifiable materials are the applicant's responsibility. The university does not accept paper materials by mail.

● Admission documents will be sent to the email address provided in the application form. Ensure accuracy. Only electronic admission documents are provided; applicants must print them.

● Scholarship recipients must bring original documents (including formal graduation certificates if pre-graduation proofs were submitted) for verification during registration.

● The university does not authorize any individuals or agencies for

Chinese Government Scholarship recruitment. Contact the university directly for scholarship matters. Do not trust any "guaranteed placement" paid services.

2. Review and Admission Process

The university will review application materials and conduct interviews for qualified candidates (notifications sent via email from official university email addresses ending with "@kmmu.edu.cn"). Admissions are merit-based.

(1) Preliminary review: The university will review information and attachments. Results are only provided on the "Kunming Medical University International Student Admission Platform" (<http://study.kmmc.cn> or <https://kmmc.17gz.org/>). Ensure email accuracy.

(2) Pre-admission: Qualified applicants proceed to online video interviews. Notifications and interview methods are sent via email. Check emails promptly to avoid missing interviews (missed interviews are considered voluntary withdrawal).

(3) Provisional admission: Applicants passing interviews enter the "provisional admission" stage. The university organizes an expert panel to review all provisional admissions.

(4) Final admission: Self-funded students are selected by the expert panel based on merit. Scholarship recommendations are submitted to

higher authorities for final approval. Results are notified via email/WeChat.

VI. Registration

1. Per the Chinese Ministry of Education's "paperless office" requirement, the university issues electronic admission notices and JW202/JW201 forms via email, not paper copies.
2. Admitted students must apply for an X1 visa within the timeframe specified in the admission notice and report to the university with all original application and admission materials.
3. Those unable to register must request leave in writing in advance. Unauthorized late registration results in canceled admission.

VIII. University Scholarships and Financial Aid

1. Freshmen Financial Aid

For first-year self-funded students who pay full tuition. Students apply, and the university reviews and disburses aid monthly over 10 months per academic year based on performance.

2. Academic Scholarships

For self-funded undergraduates and graduates from the second year until the end of the standard program duration. Awards are based on annual exam/ research performance (top 70%) and daily conduct (30%).

Scholarships are disbursed annually, covering 70% of students: First prize (10%), Second prize (20%), Third prize (40%).
